A Safety and Health Specialist Certificate in Construction, General Industry, Industrial Hygiene or Healthcare is awarded to candidates who successfully complete the core and elective requirements listed by area of specialty. Participants in the Safety and Health Specialist Certificate Program can tailor their course requirements to meet specific workplace safety needs. Courses listed under multiple certificates allow the participant to apply for and work on more than one certificate with each course completion. Participants have four years from the date of application to the Certificate Program to reach completion.
